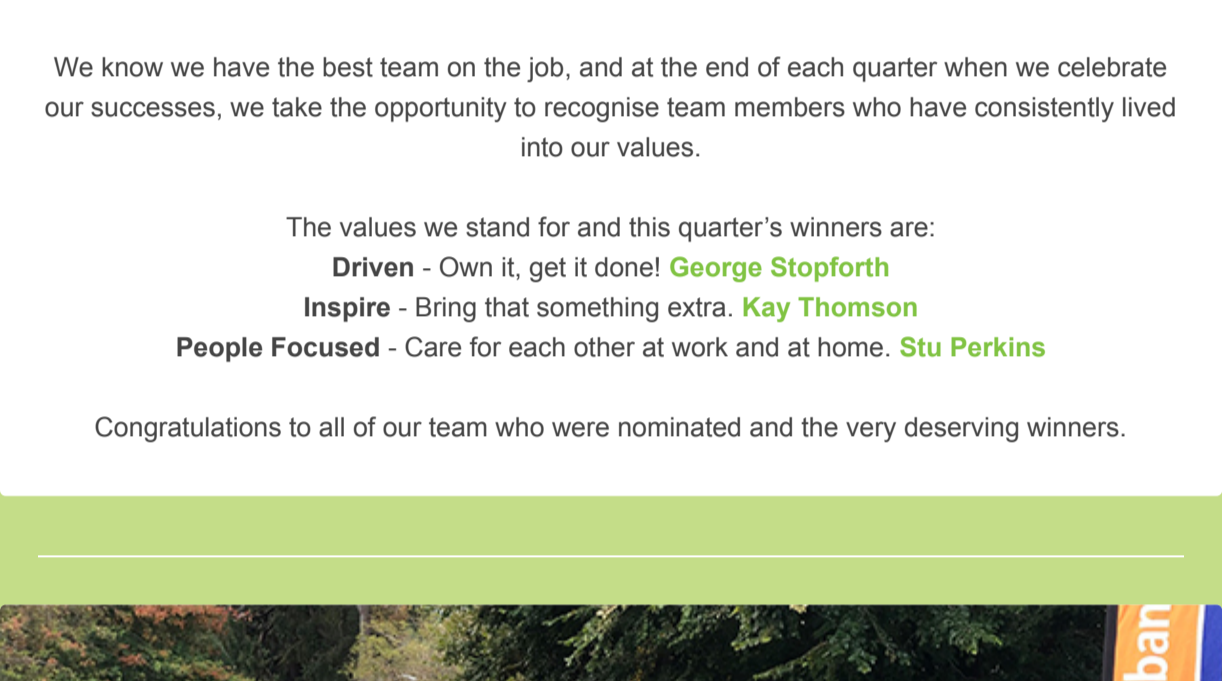

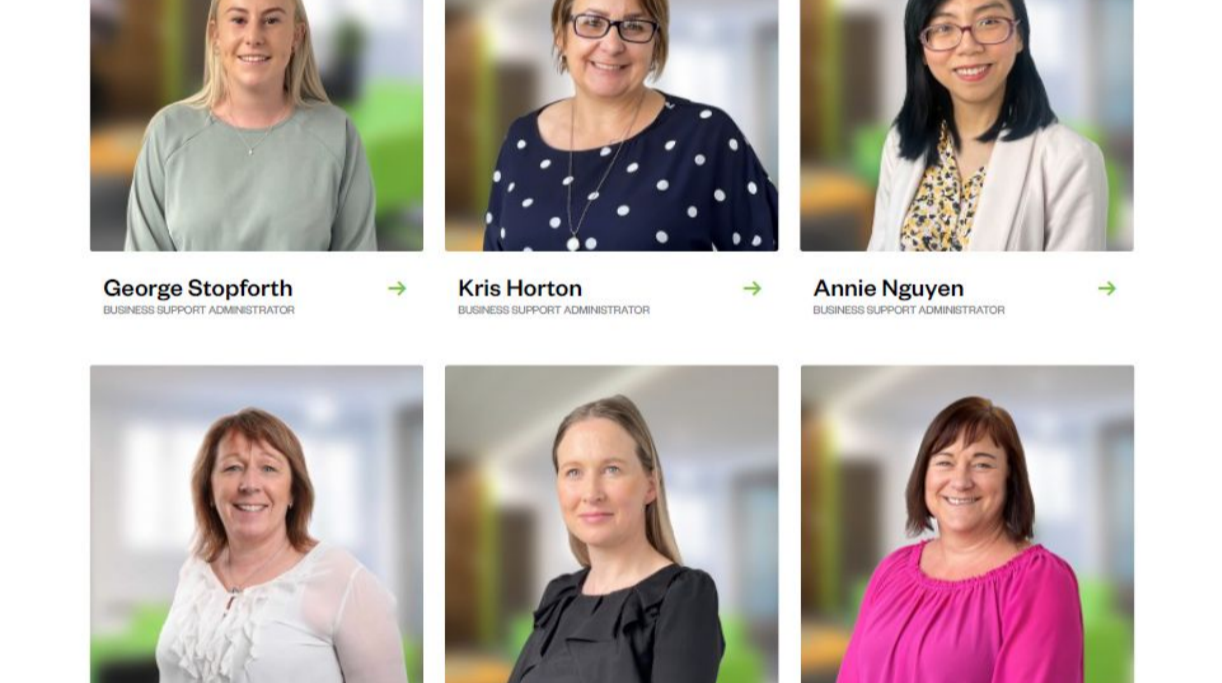
Ignite Leadership Programme

Ashley Burdon, our Head of Business Advisory and Development, presented the importance of a business plan at Rabobank's client council event, **Ag Pathways 2023**.

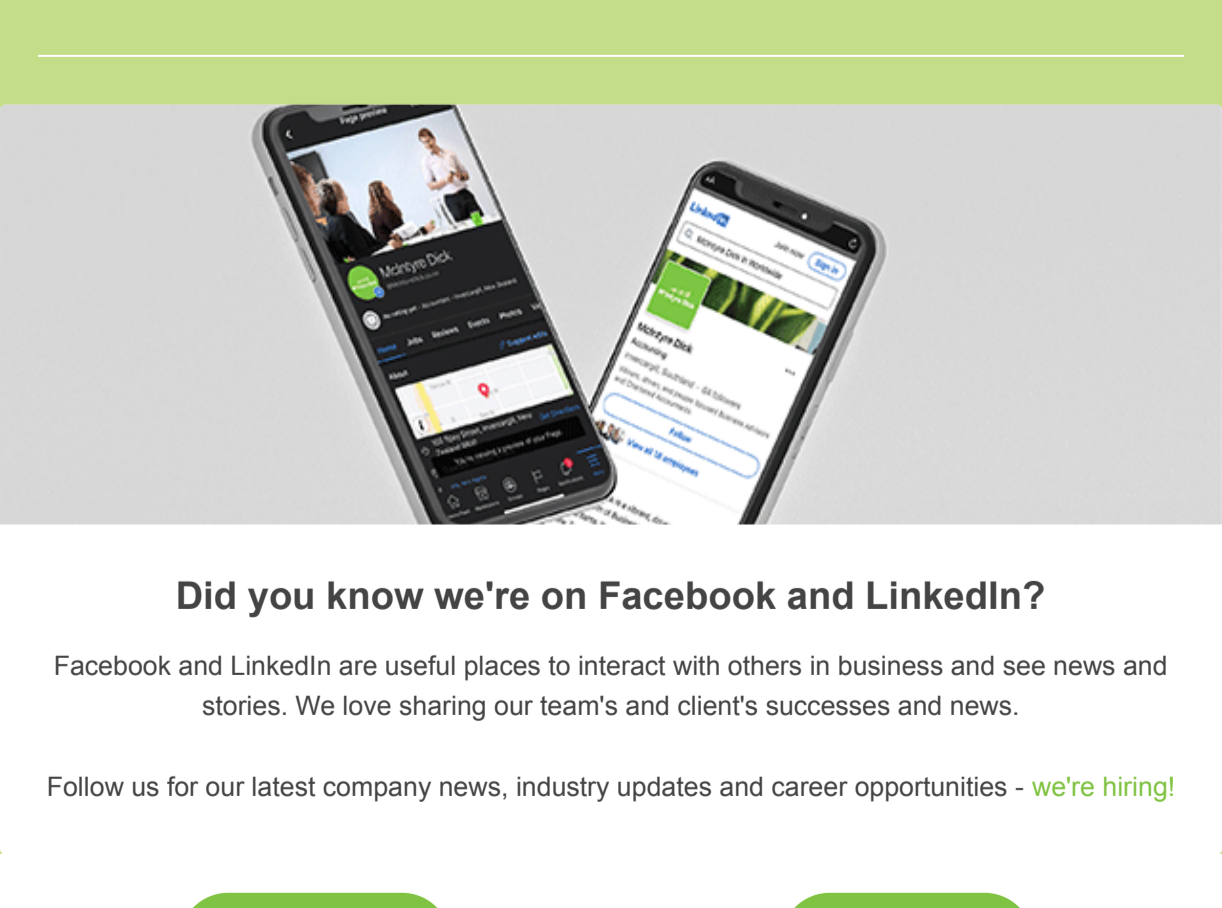
